How to create tables in OECD.Stat

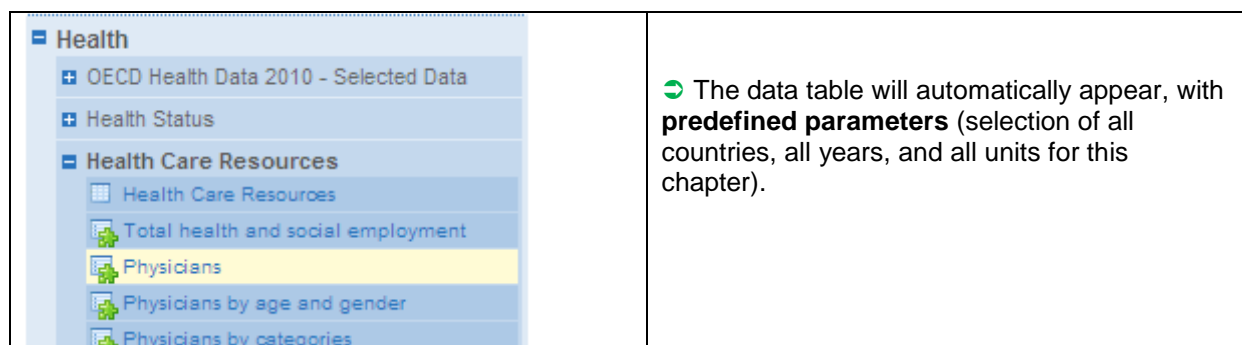
1. To go to **OECD.Stat**, click on <http://stats.oecd.org/Index.aspx>.
2. Go to the theme **Health** in the list on the left



3. Click on that theme to open it: you will then see all the data sets which are part of **OECD Health Data 2011**.



4. To **access the data tables**, click inside a data set (for instance Health Care Resources in the example below), and click on the chapter you want to access (for instance Physicians).



- To **modify the parameters**, click on the items on the top menu bar, such as **Variable**, **Unit**, **Country** or **Year**, and click on “View data” once done. You can also export your selection directly into Excel. See image below.

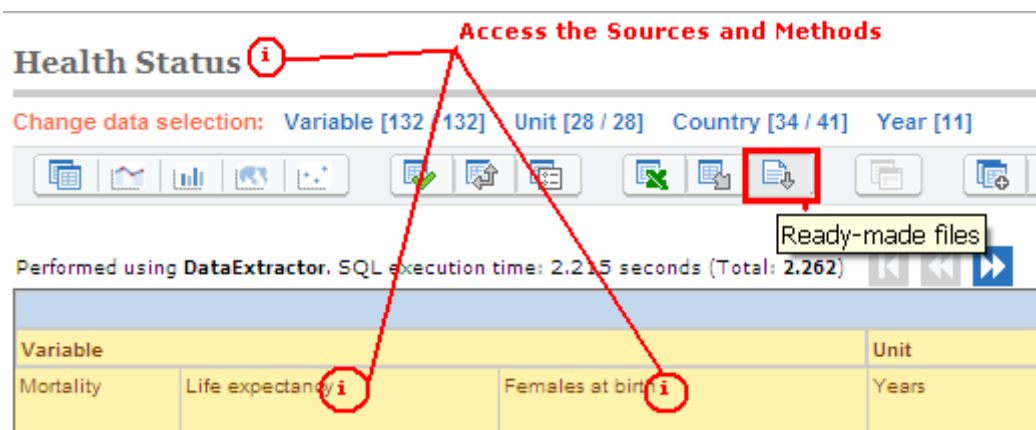
